Several clinical reports have suggested efficacy for IAP in reversing cerebral vasospasm, both in the acute setting, ie, during papaverine infusion, and in the long-term setting, ie, hours or days after treatment Accordingly, IAP has been shown to reverse or improve both angiographic and transcranial Doppler (TCD) sonographic vasospasm6,8
