### **Starting herb seeds**

Growing herbs from seeds is not much different than growing vegetables, with two big exceptions Many herbs take much longer to germinate and have lower germination rates than vegetables Patience is essential when growing herbs! It is not unusual for seed to take two to four weeks to

germinate, although some herbs are much faster
