Home & Healthy for Good 2 Health Care Costs of Chronic Homelessness Chronically homeless people, defined by the federal government as those who have experienced repeated or extended stays of a year or more on the street or in temporary shelter and have a disability, constitute about ten percent of the homeless population 5
