### **Bark Beetles - Tuolumne County, California**

bark surface Red turpentine beetles are larger than engraver beetles, red-dish brown, and have a rounded tip to the abdomen (Fig 1) Their presence is indicated by large, pinkish brown to white pitch tubes (a mixture of pine sap and beetle boring dust that ap-pears on the lower trunk, Fig 2)

### **Release of *Galerucella californiensis* and *Galerucella* ...**

Once the population of beetles reaches a level that results in significant reduction of purple loosestrife (50% defoliation), the beetles disperse to new loosestrife infestations (Wiebe 2000) The first dispersal by beetles of 185 miles from the Amwell Lake release site was documented in 2002
